About the Homework Club

The Homework Club provides a friendly and welcoming environment where secondary students can receive help from volunteer tutors with their homework and educational needs. The program focuses on support for students from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds and aims to provide a holistic education service to students.

The Homework Club offers:

- volunteer specialist tutors in a range of subject areas, including maths, English and science
- study skills including research, essay writing and time management
- help with planning tertiary education and career pathways and job application skills
- specific support for students with English as an additional language
- informal mentoring from volunteer tutors
- multiple study areas including a computer room with printing facilities and a quiet area
- access to library and VCE resources.

Who is eligible?

All secondary school students from Year 7 to 12 (including VCE and VCAL) and English Language students up to the age of 25.

Monday to Friday during school terms from 4pm-6pm and school holiday sessions.
