



Mentoring program

The CEA mentoring program fosters relationships between Victorian Chemistry teachers to assist in the development of quality Chemistry teaching. Although there are many resources available to VCE Chemistry teachers, it can be difficult for new and/or isolated teachers to find and sort through resources that meet their particular needs. A mentor who can answer specific queries, make specific suggestions and share examples from their own experience can be very useful.

Areas that mentors may be able to assist with include:

- Structuring the VCE year
- Accessing and choosing available resources
- Planning and assessing School Assessed Coursework
- Preparing students for exams
- Revision ideas
- Ideas on how to teach particular concepts
- Reassurance

CEA will match mentors to teachers, based on areas of interest or geographical location. We will provide guidelines and ongoing support to the mentoring relationship as it may be needed.

Teachers who have extensive experience and involvement in the teaching of VCE Chemistry.
